HOW TO GET THERE

By Road: M62 to Junction 17, onto Bury New Road towards Prestwich. Follow this until a right turn into Great Cheetham Street West, left at traffic lights onto Great Clowes Street. Continue until a right turn into Silk Street, leading onto Chapel Street, left into Chapel Street. The cathedral is at 250 Chapel Street. There are many other routes—see the A-Z.

By Rail: train to Manchester Victoria, then a train to Salford Central (a train about every 10 mins). Turn left out of Central station to Chapel Street, left again, the cathedral is a few minutes walk on the right-hand side.

NB Salford Central is closed from 6.00 pm Sat and all day Sun. Salford Crescent remains open (1 train an hour), walk straight back to the cathedral. Frequent buses from Cannon Street (Stands Cm, CI) stop outside the cathedral.
